SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) is the standard security technology for establishing an encrypted link between a web server and a browser. The Virtual Office platform provides you with an SSL certificate to ensure that all data passed between the web server and browsers remain private and secure. For quality control reasons, VO provides all clients with a 3rd-party verified SSL Certificate.

Please complete this form if your company has a preexisting SSL certificate on your Web Access URL. Revoking an existing SSL is a critical step in the onboarding process and requires you to either share specific information with VO or to complete the revocation yourself. While we know that it is not always an option, Virtual Office would prefer to act on your behalf to make this change in order to facilitate the overall onboarding process.
